

# Militants kill Kaduna butcher in Port Harcourt

**M**ilitants killed two persons including a suya seller from Kaduna state in an attack in Port Harcourt.

state was said to have been killed by two militants who came on a motorcycle and shot directly at him, shattering his skull and

removing one of the eyes.

*Daily Trust* gathered that the militants were pursuing a cultist who disappeared within the area where Dan Dogoa was sitting with his friends.

According to the owner of the "suya" spot at 34/36 Victoria Street, Port Harcourt city, Abdul Mu'minu Abubakar, one of the two militants ordered his colleague to fire towards the direction they were sitting.

"One of them pointed at our direction and asked the other to fire. He shot thrice and the bullets hit Dan Dogoa whose skull was shattered and one of his eyes removed"

"We were fifteen sitting around the place at about 1.00 pm. When this happened and the two militants had fled, we rushed the victim to hospital but he died way the hospital. So they refused to admit us. We brought the corpse to Hausa Line and could not bury it till 7.00pm when the tension subsided"

## Four Jigawa PDP supporters die in motor accident

**A**t least four people among the Jigawa allegation to the just concluded PDP presidential campaign launch in Lagos died when the bus they were travelling in crashed on the way back to Dutse.

According to witnesses at the scene along Zaria-Kano road, the accident was said to have claimed the live of the driver and one other passenger believed to be his conductor involving a luxury bus and a truck also believed to be heading to Kano.
