Mrs Tope Awe, a passenger on the bus, said just be-

fore the two men were hit, the driver began shouting that his brake had failed, throwing everyone on board into panic.

At the hospital, it was gathered that one of the victims, Rilwan Abdullahi, 22, from Zamfara state, was confirmed dead and handed over to the police. As at press time yesterday, the police had handed the corpse to one Kabiru Shitu of 16, Garki village, who claimed to be the

deceased brother, for burial at

the Garki cemetery.

The other victim, who was identified as Jamilu, is under intensive care at the hospital.

Nobody in the coaster bus was injured except 14year-old Chika Usonu of Ebonyi state, who had a slight injury and is receiving treat-

ment at the hospital.
