

OPC members kill *okada* rider, passenger over traffic obstruction

Members of the Oodua Peoples Congress (OPC) over the weekend macheted a commercial motorcycle rider, popularly called *okada*, and his passenger to death along the Ahmadiya bus-stop, Ijaiye, Ojokoro, a Lagos suburb.

The deceased identified as Jelili Adetunji and Idowu Makanjuola, were on their way to Sango-Ota in Ogun state when they met their death.

According to sources, the incident took place when the duo ran into OPC men numbering about 20 in a Toyota Hiace bus with registration number XC 781 AGL covered with a banner with the inscription Gani Adams, Onikoyi unit, Orile Agege.

It was gathered that four of the OPC mem-

bers suddenly rushed down from the vehicle with machetes and hacked the duo to death for obstructing their vehicle.

It was also gathered that the *Okada* rider may have obstructed the way of the OPC men, preventing them from moving at high speed as there was no other reason for the OPC men's action.

Police detectives from Ojokoro Police Station rushed to the scene, but the OPC men had escaped.

The police men reportedly vowed to track down the fleeing OPC men since their vehicle registration number was known to them.

As at the time of filing in this report, the bodies of the deceased were deposited at a mortuary.
