

Armed robbers kill deputy governor's son

Armed robbers shot dead the eldest son of the Kebbi State deputy governor yesterday. Late Hayatu Ibrahim K. Aliyu was on Saturday night shot along the Kontagora – Yauri road while traveling to his hometown Warra, in Yauri local government area of Kebbi

Aged 35, late Hayatu was a staff of NNPC in Lagos before he met his demise on the fateful Saturday. The body of late Hayatu has since been buried according to Islamic rites.
