Tanker crushes six to death

Golf car which was coming from the opposite direction. He said the tanker swerved

several times before it crushed the coming vehicle, killing all the six passengers.

The eyewitness said the driver of the tanker was heard shouting that the brake of the vehicle had failed and struggling with the vehicle to avert the accident.

It took the effort of sympathises

to recover two dead bodies which were taken to Ankpa General Hospital Mortuary while others were mangled beyond recognition.

When Daily Trust visited the hospital, the two women recovered were said to have been deposited at the mortuary, but their identity was not ascertained at the time.
