THREE DIE IN ABAJI CRASH

Three persons were killed while fifteen others sustained various degrees of injuries in an 18-seater Commuter Hiace bus that was involved in a road accident at Abaji-Lokoja Road yesterday.

Witnesses told City News that the accident happened around 1:00 am a few meters away from Abaji when the driver of the commuter Hiace bus loaded a passenger from Lokoja going to Abuja, lost control of the vehicle while on high speed as he was blinded by the strong headlights of a vehicle from the opposite direction. As a result, the

driver crashed into a broken down lorry by the side and two persons were killed on the spot.

City News further gathered that 15 occupants in the bus sustained injuries, while one person later died after the victims were rushed to Abaji General Hospital by men of the Federal Road Safety Commission.

The Abaji Unit Commander of the Federal Road Safety Commission (FRSC), Mr. E.D Adebisi, while confirming the incident to our reporter said the three corpses had been taken to Gwagwalada Specialist Hospital Motuary.

Hospital sources at Abaji General Hospital told our reporter that those who sustained minor injuries had been treated and discharged.
