Middle aged man strangled in Kano

A middle aged man, Mallam Aminu Danladi, has been strangled by unknown assailants at Lahadin-Makole town, few kilometers away from the Kano metropolis.

It was reported that the deceased was on his way to a nearby town on Sunday night when the unknown assailants struck.

A close friend of the deceased who preferred to remain anonymous, told Daily Trust that the killers also carted the deceased's money and other belongings.

He further confirmed that the deceased wasn't dismembered.

"Late Aminu was on his way to Wudil town to purchase some goods for his usual business but unknown to him, the taxi he boarded belonged to the killers. From what we gathered, Mallam Aminu boarded the taxi from Mariri town accompanied by three other people who pretended to be passengers and on their way, they killed my friend and carted all his belongings," he said.

He narrated further: "While they were approaching Lahadin-Makole, the killers used a cable wire and strangled the deceased before they removed all his money and other items in his possession."

When contacted, the police command public relations officer, DSP Baba Muhammad, said police are not aware of the incident.

He however advised commuters in the state to always ensure that they hire commercial vehicles from designated motor parks.
