# Male corpse found at ‘One Man village’

A male corpse was yesterday seen lying by the roadside along Abuja - Keffi road at ‘One Man’ village in Nasarawa State.

The head of the corpse appeared battered and it was tied with a shirt.

Residents of the area

crowded the dead man and were seen wondering what must have caused the death of the man.

One of the residents was overheard saying that the

man might have been knocked down by a vehicle at the wee hours of the morning while trying to cross the express road.

“We saw the corps last

night when we were returning home at about 10:30pm after our driver flashed his full headlamps and told his passengers that a human being was lying on the road,” the resident said.

Another female resident, who disputed the accident theory, said he might have been killed somewhere and abandoned by the roadside.

One person in the crowd said he saw the man inside a local drinking joint and that he thinks that the man was a native of Mangu in Plateau State.

At the police station, a police officer on duty expressed shock saying that their men always patrol the area at night and wondered why they could not see the corpse. He sent a policeman to accompany a reporter to the spot where the body lay.

Before the reporter left the scene, the men of the motor traffic department of the New Karu police station (MTD) arrived the place and at 12 noon when the reporter went back to the scene, the corps had already been taken away.
