flies all over her body. There were some ritual things like two eggs, charms, and blood on the table beside her. Her body was tied with rope and her head was put in a divided

An uncle of the deceased. Mr Bassey Ekamon, also told husband is a preacher.

He said: "He is the main cul-

prit because even before they were married on 17th November last year, the church had to stop contracting the marriage

because of his occult activities. but later on, they got married. He has finally killed her and left the compound empty. It took the police three hours before
