Makau, who was representing Maru constituency in the house was a commissioner for finance under the defunct administration of former Governor Ahmed Sani Yarima.

The state commissioner for information, Alhaji Ibrahim Dan-Maliki, described the death of the legislator as very shocking and a great loss to the state.

"The death of Hon. Bello Makau has really shocked us. It was very shocking and disturbing. But there is really nothing one can do, save to pray to the Almighty Allah to accept their souls and grant them paradise.

"The state government has concluded arrangements to recover their bodies and give them a befitting burial according to Islamic injunctions. The state is in a state of mourning," he said.

Meanwhile, the legislator was yesterday evening buried along with his younger brother in their hometown, Dansadau.
