ROBBERS KILL 500 LEVEL VARSITY STUDENT

Thursday, 24 April 2008

A 500 level student of the Federal University of Technology, (FUTO), Owerri, Donald Eme Chukwudi, of the Department of Environmental Technology was early yesterday shot dead by armed robbers at Eziobodo in Owerri North LGA of Imo State.

Reports said the robbers broke into the students hostel and robbed them of their money and other belongings.

During the incident, Donald was shot by the robbers while about 20 other students sustained injuries.

The injured have been taken to the Federal Medical Center, Owerri for treatment.

Angered by the killing, other students went onto the streets and attacked villagers.

The PRO of the institution, Ada Eze Okani who confirmed this to Daily Trust, said Donald died on the way to the FUTO health center saying that the attack on the students who were off campus, sparked clashes with the youths of the Eziobodo community.
