The Gombe State Police Command has confirmed the murder of one Ibrahim Muhammad, a student of the University of Maiduguri, at the notorious Gandu quarters in the state capital.

The Deputy Police Commissioner, Barrister Nicholas Nkemedem said the police had not made any arrest but were on the hunt for the perpetrators.

A witness at the scene of the incident, who sought anonymity said the deceased was stabbed in his stomach by a group of thugs, which led to his death.

He added that if paraded, he would be able to identify one or two among the killers.

Gandu ward is the same place where one motorcyclist and a female teacher were killed recently.

Daily Trust also learned that due to the gravity of criminal activities in the area, the police had maintained a day and night patrol of the area, but with the recent absence of the police, criminal activities re-emerged.
