Son kills father over neglect

Two kids found dead in car

lwo kids were found dead inside a parked blue Nissan Primera car at Abesan estate in Inaia area of Lagos at the weekend. The children identified as Timilehin Adewunmi, aged four, and three year old Olamide Ajibola were said to have locked themselves inside the car and died of suffocation. The parents of the deceased children. Daily Trust gathered, had gone to attend a wedding ceremony, leaving the children in custody of one of their son believing that he would be able to take care of them. The children went to the car with registration number EA685EKY belonging to a woman in block 308, locked themselves in and died. One of the parents of the children. Mr Ghenga Adewunmi narrating the incident, said they came back home to discover that the two kids were missing and had organized a search party for them when the owner of the car came out of her flat to discover the dead bodies of the two kids. She raised an alarm which attracted everyone to the scene. The case was reported at Ipaja police station and Mrs. Abiandu was arrested as prime suspect. Adewunmi who described the woman as a good woman said it was an accident
