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Nigeria: 1 Killed, Many Injured in Communal Clash

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One person was killed and many others injured in a clash over land between the people of Share in Ifelodun and Tsaragi Local Government Areas council Areas of Kwara State.

Many houses were destroyed by the rampaging youths from the two communities.

The palace of Olupako of Share and the local government sece-tariat in Share town were repor-tedly torched by the rioters.

It was gathered that the fight, which started on Sunday eve-ning, continued till the early hours of Monday, when the anti-riot policemen were drafted to restore law and order in the two communities.

The police spokesperson, Alhaji Tunde Mohammed, who confirmed the incident, said peace was gradually returning to the two communities.

Eyewitness account claimed that the crisis started when the people of Sharagi attempted to stop construction work on a disputed piece of land close to the United Missionary School (UMCA) in Share.

The Chairwoman of Ifelo-dun Local Government Area, Alhaja Nimota Amuda, told newsmen at the police head-quarters in Ilorin that she narrowly escaped being lyn-ched at the palace of one of the traditional rulers in the area.

She said she had appealed to the people of the two com-munities to embrace peace.

Amuda said a dusk to dawn curfew had been imposed on the two communities,as part of efforts to restore peace in the areas.

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She commended the state police command for respon-ding promptly in quelling the clash, by deploying more than 200 anti-riot policemen to main-tain law and order in the areas. (NAN).

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
