

Motorist crushes police officer at New Karu

An Assistant Superintendent of Police, Samuel Dashi was recently crushed to death by an unknown motorist, very close to the New Karu Police Station.

A police source told our reporter that the officer was crossing the expressway to the station when the accident happened.

"The unfortunate thing about the incident is that Supol Dashi had less than six months to retire from the force before he died," the officer lamented.

He said the Divisional Police Officer has ordered a full inves-

tigation, while efforts are on to trace the motorist.

In another development, tragedy struck the family of Police Inspector Attah, when their son Ukpahi Attah was stabbed to death as he tried to settle two friends in front of Kasham Hotel at Area D, Nyanya.

According to a police source, the boy heard noise outside his residence and went outside to discover that some people he knew were quarrelling and exchanging fists.

"While attempting to sepa-

rate them, one of those fighting drew out a sharp object and stabbed Ukpahi, who immediately slumped and died on the way to the General Hospital,

Asokoro.

"The case is been investigated by the Divisional Police Headquarters Nyanya, while the principal suspect that

stabbed the deceased has been arrested and the victim buried at his home town in Kogi State," the officer said.

At the Nyanya Police Station, a policeman, who confirmed the arrest of the suspect, told our reporter that the case is under investigation.

Police arrest man over

A vigilant mobile policeman yesterday arrested a man that carried a month-old baby in a vehicle that was heading for Lafia.

The policeman, who was a

passenger in the vehicle, noticed how the baby was wailing uncontrollably and he requested for the baby's mother and was told by the man that
