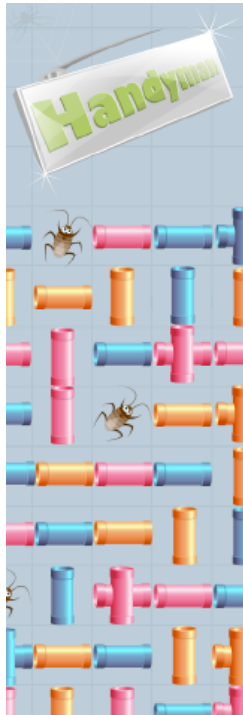

Nigeria: Three Die in Auto Crash

Three persons lost their lives, while 12 others were seriously injured in a ghastly motor accident on Wednesday at Abaji town, along the Abuja-Lokoja highway.

An eye witness said the accident occurred in the early hours of the morning and involved a Daf truck with registration number XA 828 BAU that was loaded with goats and cattle.

"The truck driver, who was on top speed suddenly lost control of his vehicle near Con oil and crashed into a ditch, killing three persons on the spot and injuring 12 others," the witness said.

He said immediately after the accident, officials of the Abaji unit command of the Federal Road Safety Commission were alerted and they rushed down to carry out rescue operations by taken the injured to Abaji General Hospital and St Peter's Clinic.

Our reporter who visited the scene of the crash yesterday watched as Abaji sanitation officials buried 82 dead rams by the road side.

Reacting to the accident, Abaji Unit Commander of the FRSC, Mr. Joseph Ojerinde, said the human corpses have been deposited at the University of Abuja Teaching Hospital's Morgue.

In a related development, one person died, while two others sustained injuries Wednesday evening in another accident that occurred at Kilankwa junction, near Dabi village on the same road.

Mr. Tukur D. Sifawa, Kwali unit commander of FRSC, said the accident happened when one of the front tyres of the truck pulled out and the driver jumped out, adding that the truck fell on the driver, killing him instantly.

He said the truck driver's corpse has been deposited at the University of Abuja Teaching Hospital's Morgue, while the injured are on admission at the same hospital.
