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Suspected killers of 12 year old nabbed

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Suspected killers of a 12 year old girl in Ifon, Ifon Orolu Local Government Area of Osun State have been nabbed by the police .

The victim, Rofiat Ojewole who was killed on Monday was a Primary 5 pupil of the Eternal Rock Primary School, Ifon .

Investigations revealed that the girl was killed on the premises of a Cherubim and Seraphim church and vital organs of her body were removed.

It was said that the deceased was sent by her mother to fetch water at the back of the church when she was taken by her killers. Her body was later found inside the church by a relative. Youths in the town on hearing the news burnt down the church.

The Police Public Relations Officer, ASP Olabode Akinola who confirmed the incident said there was an allegation that the head of the church masterminded the killing. He promised to ensure that anyone found guilty of the crime is made to pay. Meanwhile, the traditional ruler of the town, the Olufon of Ifon-Orolu has appealed to the youths to be calm, saying the police would unravel the killers.

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
