## 2 killed as rearers/farmers clash in Maigatari

TWO persons were confirmed dead and two others seriously injured in Hana-Kango village of Maigatari Local Government Area of Jigawa State following a clash between pastoralists and farmers.

Daily Trust gathered that 18 farmlands were completely destroyed during the clash which involved pastoralists from Niger Republic and Nigerian farmers.

Those who lost their lives in the crisis include Alhassan Idi

of Niger Republic and Mal. Jaji Tata.

Chairman of Maigatari Local Government, Alhaji Isa Zakari Bosuwa said 6 patrol vehicles were deployed to the area to beef security.

Bosuwa said the two injured persons were receiving treatment at Gumel General Hospital.

Police authorities also confirmed the arrest of 5 pastoralists and the recovery of a Kalasin model gun and ammunition.

Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO), ASP Abdul Jinjiri said investigation is still on.
