FG inaugurates Project C'ttee for PPP

Hoodlums kill traditional ruler over land

The traditional ruler of Ajuwon, Ogun State, Akibu Ajuwon, was on Sunday killed by some hoodlums who claimed they were land owners called 'Omo onile' for his failure to pay them N50,000.

Daily Trust learnt that the deceased was putting finishing touches to his house located on plot 26, Olurinde street, Orile Agege when three young men approached him and demanded that he paid N 50,000 to them or stop work at the site. They were said to have asked the workers to stop work. Our correspondent gathered that the late Baale offered the boys led by one Lukman Laloko N5, 000 with a bottle of soft drink, but the boys rejected the offer.

The boys then brought out a powdery substance and blew it into the face of the deceased and he collapsed immediately. He was rushed to a nearby private hospital where he was later referred to the general hospital but he died before getting there. The matter was reported to the Elere police station after which Lukman was arrested and the others escaped.
