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FG inaugurates Labour Advisory Council

Three die in Ilorin gang clash

Three persons have been arrested by Police in Kwara over a recent clash between two rival groups of a political party which resulted in the death of three people. Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO) ASP Ezekiel Dabo said violence recently broke out at the Kuntu Area of Ilorin town, but that the situation had been brought under control with the recent arrest of the three.

A witness told Daily Trust yesterday said that the clash followed the death of one Nuru Alowonle, who was said to have been killed at a social gathering within the area a day before the incident.

The sources said Nuru's gang on hearing of the death of their leader, mobilized and attacked their rivals who they claimed were responsible for his death.

Dangerous weapons including guns were said to have been used. Property such as vehicles belonging to the rival groups and other residents of the area were destroyed. Speaking further, ASP Ezekiel Dabo said residents should go about their normal businesses and not entertain any fear, as the command is equal to the task.
