## 30-year-old stabbed to death over millet at Kwali

A 30 year old man, Abdullahi Dankaza, was stabbed to death by his colleague Danlami Garba, at abattoir Thursday morning following a disagreement that arose over the sharing of a bag of millet at Kwali Area Council.

An eyewitness, Abubakar Sani, said trouble started when a bag of millet and sugar was sent to members of the meat sellers at abattoir by a politician to shaer it among the members as free Ramadan gift when Garba (culprit) highjacked it.

According to him, the bag of millet and sugar was brought to them through an aide of a politician of the council who dropped the items at abattoir where Garba invited an Okada rider to convey the millet and sugar to his house.

He said Garba became visibly angry when Abdullahi (deceased) queried him for diverting the bag of millet and sugar that was meant to be shared among meat sellers to his house and for being always "greedy and disrespectful to elders."

The tease however, annoyed Garba who angrily disputed the remark and immediately engaged in a brawl and pulled out his knife and stabbed Dankaza on his back and he fell down in pool of his blood and died instantly.

City News gathered that Garba became annoyed when a bag of millet and sugar was first brought to them on the first day of the fasting and shared among the meat sellers without giving him his own share.

When contacted the Kwali Divisional Crime Officer (DCO), Mr. Bokah B. Audu, who confirmed the incident, said he cannot comment on the matter as he has just assumed and was still making documentation.

"Actually there was an incident like that, but I cannot comment on it, because I have just been posted from Mpape to this place.
