# Man stabbed to death in Jos

22 year old man was stabbed to death following a disagreement between him and another person in Jos A The deceased, Ziya'ulhaq Muhammad, who was simply referred to as Mamman was allegedly stabbed by Mustafa (Dan Hajiya) after the deceased accused him of stealing a door and its frame at a site they were working, Mamman's brother, Ibrahim Muhammad told our correspondent yesterday. The incident occurred at a small settlement called Yar'Kasuwa along Rikkos - Yan' Shanu road last Thursday at about 12pm

"My brother was helping one of his friends at the site he was given contract to renovate. And when they came to the site on Thursday to continue with the work they started on Wednesday, they discovered that a door and its frame had been removed from the building", Muhammad said.

A witness told our correspondent that after making inquiries, they were told that it was Mustafa who removed the door. "But Mustafa became angry over the accusation and he brought out a knife and stabbed Mamman on his left rib twice. He was rushed to the hospital, but later died on the same day", he added. Police Public Relations Officer in the state ASP Muhammed Lerama confirmed the incident, saying the accused was in their custody and would be made to face the law.
