Speaking to journalists at the scene of the accident, the Head of Operation of the Nigerian Security an Civil Defence Corps Mr.Sammani Mohammad Ringim said the accident occurred four kilometers from Gombe, explaining that a bus with registration number, Abuja XD 877 GWA and a Honda Hennessey car with he registration number, Kano AP978 TRN collided while attempting to negotiate a corner. Mr. Ringim added that the Honda hit the bus from the side of the tank, which caused a fire where seven people were burnt to death. A witness, Mallam Aminu Madaki, said they rushed the victims to the FM memediately after the accident occurred but the hospital workers refused to attend to them because there was no police escort. He added that he rushed to the state police command headquarters as well as the Gombe Area Command but other refused to give a police escort before he later went to the state command of the Federal Road Safet Commission. Commenting on the accident, the Head of Operation of the FRSC Mallam Umar Ibrahim said dangeroul riving and over speeding were identified as the causes of the accident and advised motorists to drive with aution, especially during this time of the year.
