Controversy trails Auditor-General appointment

Two die in Kachako auto crash

Two persons died while several others were injured in an auto accident in Kachako, Takai Local Government Area of Jigawa State when their vehicle collided with another one along the Kano-Birnin-Kudu highway on Sunday.

The accident occurred when a Volkswagen Golf car, which was coming from Dutse tried to over-take another vehicle but collided with a Hiace coming from the Kachako market. The incident occurred around 7:30 pm Sunday. Victims were taken to the Dutse General Hospital by personnel of the Federal Road Safety Commission.

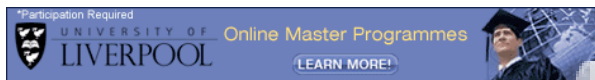
