For Murtala Yar’adua, a false alarm

Jos: ‘Eight Muslims killed in secret attacks’

The Muslim community in Plateau State said eight of its members have been killed secretly in Jos in the last two weeks.

The community in a statement by its spokesman Muhammad Sani Mudi said two water vendors were killed last week along Busa Buji Street in Jos while there were four different attacks on Muslims in Naraguta, Vom, Rukuba road and Bauchi ring road and last Sunday’s sudden disappearance of a newspaper vendor.

They said Muslims in Plateau State now live in fear as a result of what has been happening to their members recently and cannot move or go about their normal businesses freely as before.

Mudi said it is regrettable that there has been an intensification of hate campaigns as well as provocative assertions to incite the Christian community against Muslims in the state by some group of people and want the development checked.

He condemned the recent recommendation of the Pentecostal Fellowship of Nigeria (PFN) Plateau State chapter, which called on Christians to screen newspaper vendors before allowing them come near Christian gathering while not allowing them come near church building saying this may have instigated the recent development.
