Lagos govt orders demolition of structures under bridges

LG boss dies in car crash

The Chairman of Bassa Local Government Area of Plateau State Mr. Amil Anko yesterday died in a car crash which occurred along the Pankshin-Mangu high way, Public Relations Officer of the Federal Road Safety Commission (FRSC) Sa'idu Badamasi has said.

Badamasi said the accident occurred when the car carrying the chairman, a Peugeot 406, attempted to avoid a pothole on the road.

He added that when the vehicle dodged the pothole, but rammed into an electrical pole. The Plateau State government through its Commissioner for Information and Communication Gregory Yenlong has described the chairman's death as a great loss, not only to the people of Bassa, but the state.

Mr. Yenlong added that Mr. Anko was a just man who was committed to serving his people, saying he contributed immensely to the development of his people and the state.

"Truly, he will be missed and we pray God to give his family and the people of Bassa Local Government Area the fortitude to bear the loss", he said.
