Oil spillages kill 30 in Bayelsa

Oil spillages in Azuzuama Community of **Bayelsa** State have resulted to the death of over thirty children this year, a repentant militant leader of the South Wing of the Movement for the Emancipation of the Niger-Delta (MFEND) Mr. Selki Kile Torughedi said yesterday.

Mr Torughedi also known as general young shall grow therefore called on the oil companies operating in the area especially Agip Petroleum to fulfil their promises made, saying their operation in the community has caused untold hardship to the **Bayelsa** people.

Torughedi, who spoke with reporters in Abuja, warned oil companies operating in Azuzuama Community of **Bayelsa** State to stay clear of the politics surrounding the post-amnesty programme.

He said failure on the part of oil companies to distance themselves can create crisis, noting that the ex-militants are getting frustrated with the way the post-amnesty programme has been managed so far.

He gave the warning following the seeming failure of the amnesty programme designed to re-integrate repentant militants in the region back to society and proposed crucial meeting of stakeholders in the region and government functionaries.
