## Bizman killed along Jos-Riyom road

A 35-year-old foreign national, possibly Chadian, who was passing through Jos from Maiduguri on the way to Lagos, was killed by some hoodlums along Jos-Riyom road in Plateau State. The deceased, who was identified as Alhaji Muhammad Hamid Suleman, was said to be on his way to Lagos when the fuel in the 20-seater bus he was travelling in finished.

When contacted, the family of the deceased said they have written a petition which was made available to Weekly Trust dated April 7th 2010, to the Plateau State Command complaining about the killing of their member was on a business trip to Lagos. According to a nephew of the deceased: "Up till now, we are yet see his corpse to give it a befitting Islamic burial." Reacting to the incident, Plateau State Police Public Relations Officer, ASP Muhammed Lerama who confirmed the incident said they are yet to receive the full details of the incident.
