A manager with Finbank plc, Tasiu Boyi was shot dead by unknown gunmen in Abuja, the nation's capital at the weekend.

Sunday Trust gathered that the deceased; a native of Gombe State met his untimely death on his way home after the close of work on Friday evening.

It was learnt that shortly after Boyi left the Garki Area 7 premises of the bank, he was accosted and shot by gunmen.

He was rushed to the Garki Hospital for medical attention but could not make it.

When Sunday Trust visited Garki Hospital where his remains were deposited, officials of the hospital declined to make any comment on the incident.

However, the Police Public Relations Officer in the FCT police command, Superintendent Jimoh Moshood confirmed the incident, adding that the tragic incident happened in the Garki Area of Abuja.

Moshood said the late Boyi was shot and his assailants made away with his bag and other personal belongings before the police arrived the scene.

According to him, it was not clear whether the man was murdered by robbers or hired assassins, adding however, that the police were already investigating the tragic incident.
