## Tanker crushes 3 in Lokoja

A Federal Road Safety Commission official said in Lokoja, Kogi State yesterday that one person died while another was injured when a water tanker driver lost control of the vehicle and rammed into some roadside traders early yesterday.

But witnesses said they counted three dead, adding that the tanker had a brake failure and rammed into the Pata market within the city.

The Sector Commander of the Federal Road Safety Commission (FRSC) Mr Yomi Asaniyan told our correspondent that only one roadside female trader died while a man sustained injuries. He said the corpse of the victim had been deposited at the mortuary of the Federal Medical Centre, Lokoja where the injured was also receiving treatment.
