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Six killed in Niger car crash

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Not less than six persons have been crushed to death at Farin Doki, along Minna/Suleja expressway late last Thursday as an Onitsha-bound luxury bus overran a Toyota salon commercial cab.

According to one Abdullahi who witnessed the sad incident, it happened due to blurry visibility caused by the heavy downpour, adding that the luxury bus with registration number XH993 ABJ overran the Minna bound Toyota Corolla car with registration number AA767MSG.

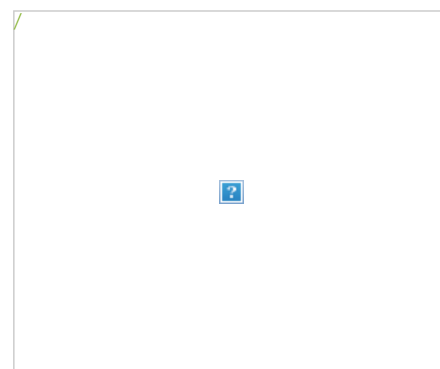
It was also gathered that nobody sustained injury in the luxury bus as they were safely cradled high above the shattering metal below as the Toyota crumbled under the weight of the bus.

Confirming the accident, the Niger state Sector Commander of the Road Safety Corps, Commander Emmanuel Abe, who on his part blamed the accident on recklessness on the part of the two drivers which made it impossible for any of the drivers to avoid the collision.
