Three killed in tanker explosion



Pandemonium as cop kills driver over N50

THERE was pandemonium yesterday at Egbeda area of Lagos State when a policeman allegedly shot and killed a commercial bus driver over N50.

There was breakdown of law and order for over one hour during which the police patrol van in which the killer police rode to the point where he shot the driver was burnt while some property were vandalized by irate drivers.

Witnesses told our correspondent that a police patrol van waylaid the commercial bus plying Egbeda-

Akowonjo route demanding N50.

Reacting to the incident, Police Public Relations Officer in Lagos, Mr. Frank Mba, confirmed that the killer policeman had been detained while a reinforcement team was sent to the scene to ensure that normalcy returned. According to him, 24 people connected to the vandalisation of people's property and the police patrol vehicle were arrested.

Meanwhile, the body of the late driver has been deposited at the mortuary of Lagos State University Teaching Hospital, Ikeja for autopsy, the police spokesman confirmed.
