

Woman electrocuted in Kebbi

A woman, who has been identified as Mrs. Barnabas was at the weekend electrocuted in Badariya area of Kebbi State.

The woman, who until her death was a prominent member of the Redeemed Christian Church of God in the state, was electrocuted while attempting to spread clothes in their compound.

According to a family source, the wire upon which the late woman attempted to spread her clothes was linked to a live wire from an electric pole outside their house.

“It is indeed a tragic incident for the Barnabas family and members of the Redeemed Church. That fateful day, she was full of life, she was cooking while washing clothes at the same time. Barely 15 minutes after she called her husband for lunch, she died. The potatoes she was eating was found in her mouth,” a family source said.

The source added that the late woman, who was nursing a six-month-old baby, lost her mother 3 months ago.
