Nigeria: Mother, Daughter Die in Kwali Auto Crash

A mother, her five- year- old daughter and one other person last Thursday evening lost their lives in a fatal motor accident that occurred at RCC junction, along Kwali-Lokoja road.

Twelve others sustained various degrees of injuries in the accident that involved an 18- seater commercial bus carrying 15 passengers.

A witness said the bus lost control and crashed into a ditch as one of its tyres burst, leading to the death of three persons on the spot, including a child.

"The bus driver lost control when one of the vehicle's back tyres burst," the witness said.

Yangoji unit Commander of the Federal Road Safety Commission (FRSC), Umar Abdullahi, who confirmed the accident, attributed it to tyre burst, saying the corpse of the deceased persons were deposited at the University of

Abuja Teaching Hospital, Gwagwalada.

He added that the 12 injured victims are at the same hospital.

In a related development, eight persons were also injured on the same day in another accident that occurred at Kamadi village, along the same road.

An eyewitness said the accident happened at around 11:23 am when a Peugeot (505) wagon car with registration number XA 576 KNE, had a burst tyre and somersaulted before crashing into a ditch, leaving eight persons seriously wounded.

Yangoji FRSC unit commander attributed the accident to tyre burst, saying the victims, comprising four males and four females, were rushed to Kwali General Hospital.
