An Ex-militant leader in the Akassa Kingdom of Brass Local Council Area of Bayelsa, Olali Abogha, alias 'Commander Areama' was reportedly killed by unknown persons on Monday night.

The News Agency of Nigeria learnt that Abogha was macheted severally by his assailants when neighbours heard his cry and forced his door open.

Abogha was rushed to the Brass General Hospital by sympathisers but died on the way.

The remains of the late warlord had been deposited at the morgue of the Brass General Hospital.

When contacted, the Bayelsa State Commissioner of Police, Aliyu Musa, confirmed the incident, saying the matter was being investigated.

Abogha was among militant leaders in Bayelsa who surrendered arms in their possession to the Presidential Amnesty Implementation Committee in Akassa in August last year.
