Assailants kill policeman attached to registration centre

A police sergeant, Aminu Yusuf was on Saturday attacked and killed by three **assailants**, who disguised as eligible voters wanting to register at Chitimo village voters' registration centre in Yukwa ward of Gwagwalada Area Council, where he was posted to secure.

Police sources in the area, said their colleague suffered a deep cut on his neck, while his rifle was taken away by the **assailants**.

They said villagers at the venue watch helplessly and could not assist because of fear of being shot at.

When our reporter visited the community, it was deserted as villagers fled the area leaving only their animals to avoid reprisal attack by the police.

A villager said many of them left the venue before the attack took place. According to him, they were disappointed with the problems caused by the INEC machine, which was taken for repairs. FCT minister's delegate lead by deputy adviser to the minister on security, retired AIG Paiko and Gwagwalada council officials visited the spot and called on elders of the community, who have taken refuge at the palace of the Zuba traditional ruler.

The elders were advised to be vigilant and report any vital information that may lead to the arrest of the perpetrators of the crime.

They were also advised to return to their community.

Our reporter gathered that Sarkin Fadan Zuba, Malam Muhammad Murtala, had one week ago received information from that village that they were having problems of domination by people from neighbouring Niger State, who could not register for the voters' **registration** exercise in their state due to indigenes/settlers issue.

At Zuba Police Station, a **policeman** confirmed the incident and referred our reporter to FCT Police Command for details.
