Armed robbers recently stormed Miya town in Ganjuwa Local Government Area of Bauchi State and killed a business man, Alhaji Baffa Nasara, taking away property and large sums of money.

In his account of the incident to newsmen yesterday, the Village Head of Miya, Alhaji Suleiman Yakubu said: "Around 2:15am I received a phone call from one of the vigilante members in the town who told me that armed robbers had attacked Alhaji Baffa Nasara in his house and in the morning they would take him to hospital in Bauchi, later he called me again and told me that

Alhaji Suleiman said later in the morning after the funeral prayer that, "they called me and asked me to come to the police station because one person was arrested and the people of the town wanted to attack him, so I went to the police station, we tried to control the mob because they were so angry. This was the third time that armed robbers are attacking people in the town. Then more policemen were brought from Kafin Madaki and took away the suspect."

Eldest wife of the deceased said, "on that night we saw nine people inside our house, they asked us to give them key they headed towards the room of our husband and broke the door and asked him for money. They machetted him and threatened to shoot him after they collected all he had and left him in blood." Police Public Relations Officer ASP Mohammed Barau said, "I haven't got the signal on the incident but any time I get it I will brief you."
