Fulani herdsman killed in Plateau village

[Share](#) A member of the Miyetti Allah Cattle Breeders Association of Nigeria (MACBAN) **Plateau** State chapter, Suleiman Jauro, has reported that **Fulani herdsman** were attacked by some people in Barkin Ladi local government area of the state, leaving one of the herdsmen dead and another wounded.

According to Jauro, seven cows were also macheted in the incident. Jauro said the incident happened on Sunday at about 4:30 pm while the herdsmen were pasturing their flocks at the back of the state polytechnic premises.

He said one of those that escaped said they saw some Berom youths living in the surrounding **villages** numbering up to 20 coming out with machetes and spears to attack them while they were grazing their cattle.

According to Jauro, when they noticed that they were heading towards them, the herdsmen who were grazing about 500 cattle took to their heels but the people gave them a hot chase and caught up with one of them whom they **killed** while wounding another.

He said the others were saved when they ran into some soldiers who prevented the people from harming them. Jauro further appealed to the federal government to do something about the constant attack on herdsmen as they can no longer take their cattle for grazing.

He said the international grazing routes had been blocked and herdsmen have to pass longer routes to avoid contact with Berom **villages**. When contacted, Special Task Force (STF) spokesman, Captain Charles Ekocho, said they were not aware of the incident and promised to contact this reporter after making enquiries, but as at the time of filing this report he did not call. **Plateau** chairman of MACBAN, Muhammad Nura, however confirmed the incident.
