Autocrash claims two along Jos-Abuja highway

AN auto crash along the Jos – Abuja highway on Sunday claimed two lives, according to the Public Relations Officer of the Federal Road Safety Commission (FRSC) in Plateau, Sa'idu Badamasi.

Speaking to our correspondent on phone, he said

the crash was caused by a head-on collision, adding that the accident occurred at about 4pm, and that it involved an OPEL Vectra vehicle with registration number, AT 147 JJN and a Honda Accord Wagon vehicle with registration number, AP 61 FGE.

"Ten people were involved in the accident,

two died while eight sustained injuries", he said.

He said those who sustained injuries are currently receiving treatment at the Vom Christian Hospital, and that the accident was due to over speeding.

Daily Trust further gathered that the deceased were a couple, who were on their way to Abuja.
