Robbers attack fast food joint in Yola, kill cop

A gang of armed robbers, numbering about 20, yesterday attacked a popular fast food joint and some business centers near the Federal College of Education along the Yola-Army barracks road in Yola, killing a police man and injuring four others.

Our correspondent reports that only last week, a gang of armed robbers raided super markets, shops and a pharmaceutical store in Yola, killed a policeman and made away with money realized from the day's sales.

A witness told Daily Trust, that the robbers arrived the area at about 9:00p.m, disarmed the security guards, and carted away an undisclosed amount of money in an operation that lasted for about 45 minutes. He said the

robbers who arrived in a convoy of three cars, caused commotion at the Federal College of Education (FCE) Yola, as students and staff ran helter-skelter for safety.

Commenting on the incident, Registrar of the college, Hajiya Fa'izah A.Ahmad said though there was pandemonium, no one was injured.

"As you can see, people are already going about their nor-

mal businesses and normalcy has returned." she said.

The state's police spokesperson, ASP Altine Daniel also confirmed the incident, but added that the police were on the top of the situation.

She confirmed that during the raid, a police man who was on duty was killed by the robbers while four other persons were injured.
