Nigeria: Businessman, 30, Found Dead in Jalingo

Jalingo — A thirty-year-old businessman was yesterday found dead in his room in a tenement compound in the Magami area of Jalingo State. The deceased, identified as Mr. Ejike Ndulue, was reportedly found dead in a pool of blood in his room by one of his neighbours.



The officer in charge of the Criminal Investigation Department (CID) in the state, Assistant Commissioner of Police (ACP) Muhammed Waya, who led a team of police detectives to the area, confirmed the incident.

The late Ndulue, from Anambra State, sold GMS accessories in Sabon Line area of the state.

One of his neighbours, Mr. Emmanuel Ogbonna, said he (Ndulue) returned home around 11:00pm on Wednesday and went indoors after putting on his generator.

Internet Gateway Content Providers "I saw him when he returned from his shop last night around 11pm. He went in and put on his generator before we both went into our rooms. When I woke up this morning, I did not see him outside which was very unusual. I then went to his door and found it open. I saw his dead body with stains of blood on his face and on the mattress," he said.

A sympathizer, who pleaded anonymity, said Ndulue could have been murdered.
