

According to

the Public Relations Officer of the Federal Road Safety Commission's (FRSC) in the state, Sa'idu Badamasi, the accident which involved a truck with registration number XF 443 JJN occurred at about 2pm near Assop Falls at Hawan Kibo. He added that the incident was caused by a burst tyre, and that there were 17 people in the vehicle.

Badamasi said the deceased has since been released to his family for Islamic burial while the other victims are currently receiving treatment at the FRSC clinic in Hawan Kibo.

Our correspondent gathered that the truck was conveying perishable items from Farin Gada market to the Southern part of the country when the incident occurred.


