

Suspected cultists kill hotel manager in Delta

HELL was let loose yesterday in Asaba, Delta State capital, when 15 suspected cultists stormed a hotel and stabbed the manager, one Felix Atu to death. According to sources, the suspected cultists

stormed the hotel premises and met the manager who resisted their entry, making them see it as a challenge.

Weekly Trust gathered that as an argument ensued, they stabbed Mr. Atu severally. Immediately the suspects left

the hotel, some of the workers rushed the victim to the hospital but he died before he could be attended to. The remains of the manager have been deposited at the Federal Medical Center (FMC) for autopsy, while the police have waded into the

matter.

When contacted, acting Police Public Relation Officer (PPRO), Monday Osayi confirmed the story but did not give details, saying "We have just gotten signal from 'B' Division about the incident."
