

# Gunmen kill 1, injure 3 in Yola

ONE man was shot to death while three others got wounded after two gunmen opened fire in Yola Adamawa state capital. The shooting happened at Luka Memorial Store in the state capital when two armed men approached the Chief executive officer of the stores and opened

fire in an apparent robbery attempt, though nothing was taken away.

The incident is happening few days after a retired Deputy Superintendent of Police (DSP) and 11 others were said to have been apprehended, over what police sources describe as large scale burglary of arms and ammunition from the armoury at the

police headquarters Yola.

An eye witness said that two men wearing caftan came into the store pretending to be customers and shot at the CEO of the store and three others. He said on hearing the sound of the gun shots the customers scampered for safety, while the gunmen made their way of escape.

Some shop owners however

said that all phone calls put to the police proved abortive as nothing positive was done to catch up with the gun men.

This is just one of the out of the series of attacks on shops and business centres in a broad day light as the menace of the armed men who usually strike in the early evenings has been making life unbearable for the people.

Some of the residents spoken to said that armed men on motorcycles and vehicles have been making life unbearable for the people, hence, the need for the state police command to intervene.

Efforts to speak to the PPRO, ASP Altine Daniel were futile as all calls to her phone didn't get through.
