TRAGEDY struck on Saturday night when 18 passengers of a commercial bus lost their lives in an accident on Saturday night at Awawa village, along Abuja-

Some villagers brought axes and other implements to remove corpses from the damaged bus. A witness said the bus was head-

ing to Port Harcourt from Jigawa

State when the incident happened. Commenting on the accident, Abaji FRSC unit Commander, Joseph Onyemauche Ezeh, said 18 males died on the spot and attributed the accident to wrongful overtaking by the commercial

bus driver. "The corpses were conveyed in a chartered bus to Jigawa State for burial as requested by the deceased persons' relatives," the

commander stated. He described the accident as the worst this year and appealed to the Federal Government to expedite action on the completion of the dualized Abuja-Lokoja road in order to save lives of innocent Nigerians.
