

Four die, 14 injured in Bauchi auto crash

FOUR people were killed yesterday while 14 others were injured in an auto crash which occurred in Kangere village along the Bauchi-Gombe road. Sector Commandant of the Federal Road Safety Corps (FRSC) Mr Zakariyya Mamman confirmed the incident to *Daily Trust*, saying, "The accident involved four vehicles and 18 people, out of which four died while 14 sustained various degree of inju-

ries. Our men visited the scene of the incident and took the injured victims to the hospital."

Mamman said the vehicles involved in the incident include, a tipper with registration number XA 491 Dass, an Opel Vectra with registration number AE 657 ALK, Opel Astra with registration number AE 130 GMW and another Opel with registration number AP 428 BAU. He said the accident was caused by dangerous overtaking and over speeding, adding that among the deceased,

were two men, one female and one child.

The sector commandant appealed to motorists to always obey traffic laws, especially during this period when there is heavy movement of vehicles on the roads.

A witness, Alhaji Bala shehu Kangere said the tipper driver was moving slowly, and the Vectra was on speed. He added that it was while the Vectra was about to overtake the tipper that the incident occurred.
