Minna — Niger State Chapter of the Christian Association of Nigeria (CAN) has announced the death of 37 people in the Christmas day bomb blast at St. Theresa's Catholic Church Madalla in Suleja Local Government Area in Niger State.



The state CAN chairman, Reverend Musa Dada, made the approuncement at a press conference yesterday in Minna, saying about 50 persons sustained various degrees of injuries and were receiving treatment in different hospitals.
