[4 NYSC staff perish in Kaduna accident](#)

Four staff of the National Youth Service Corps (NYSC) Kaduna office has been confirmed dead while nine others are currently receiving treatment at St. Gerard's Hospital following a ghastly motor accident in Kujama along Kaduna-Kachia road. Emmanuel Gwary, Daniel Yakubu, Mrs. Rhoda Akwoi and Malam Ibrahim died in the accident while returning from burial of one of their colleagues, Anthony Chechet Gora, in Gora, Zangon Kataf local government of Kaduna State.

The Director-General of the NYSC, Brig. Gen. Nnamdi T. Okore-Affia who was at the St. hospital in Kaduna to commiserate with the families of the deceased and those receiving treatment, described the incident as unfortunate. An eyewitness told Weekly Trust that the car conveying the NYSC staff lost control after trying to avoid two women and ran into a transformer.
