Journalist found dead in Jos

The lifeless body of Mr. Nansoh Silas, a journalist with the Highland FM, Federal Radio Nigeria Corporation (FRCN), was found along Zaramagada-Rayfield road in Jos yesterday.

The lifeless body with a small wound to the head was discovered by passers-by in a swamp by the roadside as early as 6 am on Thursday.

It has been deposited at the Jos University Teaching Hospital (JUTH), mortuary.

Silas was a reporter with Highland FM. He hailed from Langtang North Local Government Area of Plateau state.

Chairman of the Nigeria Union of Journalists, NUJ, Plateau state council, Mr. Katdapba Gobum said officials of the union would be visiting the radio station where Mr. Silas worked to commiserate with the management and staff of the station.
