A member of the gang Seyi Nasara told Eko Trust that when they arrived at the area around 10am they split

in and out of the bank and waiting for any opportunity" he confessed. He further confessed that they had waited for about an hour when

The Lagos State Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO), Superintendentof Police (SP), Joseph Jaiyeoba told Eko Trust that one of the suspects was killed in a shootout with police,

while three others were arrested with
